With the recent influx of families into the village there is a need for children to have a place where they can interact with other young children and parents have a space to gain adult conversation, build relationships and speak to professionals if needed.</p> <p>Longwick Pre-School team have been working with outreach services from the LA over the past year to increase parental engagement with specialist support services to support with parenting, social isolation, budgeting, SEND etc. this has been successful with our Pre-School cohort (age 2-5). However, we have noticed that some children entering the Pre-School have unsupported needs, lack social integration and have parents who are socially isolated and unaware of where to gain support.</p> <p>In order to promote better parental mental health, increase parenting capacity and socially integrate children in the community we are launching a Parent, Baby and Toddler group every Wednesday based at the Village Hall</p> |

These will include health visitors, department of work and pension and special educational needs.</p> |
