## Further information on Doorstep Selling

I have checked with Trading Standards regarding other trades people such as Milkmen calling on doors.

The Milkman I use does not do cold calling as I checked.

However, food and drink supplied regular such as Milkmen are exempt from having a pedlar licence, but they do need to do the following when calling at doors:

Here is some of the information they need to give before an order is placed:

- They must give information on company details business address (even if they are selling for another company)
- Address for customer complaints.
- A description of your goods or services and a reminder that any goods must be of reasonable quality and as described
- The total price or how this will be calculated
- How a customer can pay
- Delivery arrangements, costs and how long goods will take to arrive.

## Right to cancel

They must tell the customer they can cancel their order up to 14 days after the contract was made. They do not need to give a reason for cancelling.
