**Notice of an application for the registration of land as Town or Village Green**

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below and to all others whom it may concern. Application has been made to the Registration Authority, Buckinghamshire Council, Walton Street Offices, Walton Street, Aylesbury, by Philip Pope, Brambles, Tifnams, Owlswick Lane, Princes Risborough, HP27 9RJ under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Green) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007 for the land approximately one third of an acre adjoining to the south and southwest of Lamb Cottage in Owlswick ("**Owlswick Village Green**"). The application seeks the inclusion in the Register of Town or Village Greens of the land described in the Schedule below, which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 7 November 2023 by virtue of the Land being used by the inhabitants of the locality or neighbourhood within a locality for lawful sports and pastimes for at least 20 years, such use continuing at the time of the application.

If the Registration Authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as town or village green, it will so register the land.
